*Do you ever feel like your photo doesn't portray the scene as you saw it? You picked the shot, set the camera, and snapped the picture - yet the picture isn't what you wanted. You are not alone! Even the pros make mistakes. Let us help!*

*If you are interested in a hands-on learning experience, this workshop is for you!*

*This one-day workshop includes an early morning photo shoot at the beautiful Noxubee National Wildlife Refuge in Brooksville, MS (near Starkville, MS). Spend time outside with photographer Jason L. Price and other colleagues exploring the beauty of Noxubee and learning how to grasp and capture that beauty in your pictures.*

*Following the morning shoot, Jason will spend the afternoon critiquing photos taken that morning. Bring your laptop and work along with him. He will be working with Adobe Photoshop, but will be teaching general principles of the digital darkroom which apply to all photography software, thus Photoshop is not required.*

*Mark your calendars now and make plans to join us for this rare opportunity to get that hands-on experience. This workshop is limited to 40 people. Registration deadline is May 7, 2010.*

*Although the workshop doesn't officially start until 8 a.m., we encourage participants to get there as early as they like to start taking pictures. We will meet at 8 a.m. in the Education Center to break into groups of five and start shooting again before the afternoon critique.*

*As an added benefit, the Mississippi Wildlife Federation will compile a list of places to take pictures in Mississippi that are open to the public. This list will be distributed to participants at the workshop.*


